The last week of term sees the return of our annual Easter WOW Week.



The children split across school into their 'school family' and take part in a range of experiences and activities all with the same purpose of helping them to grow a deeper understanding of Jesus through the Easter story.

The week begins with an hour-long prayer journey. The children will visit prayer stations helping them to empathise with the journey Jesus took to the cross.

Wednesday and Thursday of that week will see the school families take part in 8 practical activities. These include art and craft activities, cooking, trails and dance. They will help the children learn about the events of Holy Week through fun and hands-on experiences.

The deadline for donations is **Thursday, 24th March** in time to start the long journey to Ukraine.

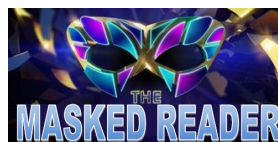
